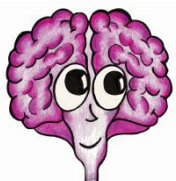

DocuBrain® TechDoc 8 Build 12/08/2014 Release Notes

These release notes only document changes for the TechDoc 8-2 patch dated 12/08/2014. Please consult the TechDoc 8-1 patch or original TechDoc 8 release notes for more information about changes introduced with those releases.

Note: The TechDoc 8-2 patch dated 12/08/2014 also includes all items addressed in TechDoc 8-1 patch dated 09/08/2014.

New Features and Improvements

DM-599: Adjust columns for Mime Type Keyword Aliases

Columns and columns headers were mismatched on the Mime Type Keyword Aliases. The data was still being displayed but the columns and the headers were slightly offset by the issue. This change allows them to line up completely.

DM-600: Add ID to SOAP Comment Service Add Operation

During work on the SOAP Regression Tester, it was noticed that the SOAP Comment Service Add Operation does not return the ID of the newly created comment. All other add/create operations return IDs. It has been updated to return the ID after the Add Operation completes.

DM-601: Add Attachments to Show Generations

Show Generation does not show its attachments on the Show Info screen like Show Document does. This has been added.

Problems Resolved

DM-597: Mass Cancelled Document Not Updated in SM

An issue was reported where a document was not updated after performing a Mass Cancel. On inspection, there was an issue with the new feature that was added in TechDoc 8 as DM-473. This has been corrected.

DM-598: Cannot Run Reports on the Attachments Table

An issue was reported with Reports on the Attachment Tables. A "late" change in TechDoc 8 to attachments broke reports and it was not caught by internal or external testing. This has been corrected.

DM-603: Update SOAP Security Handler to Properly Handle Log-In Failures

While updating the SOAP regression tester to use scripting, we identified an issue that certain log-in failures generated exceptions at an inappropriate time which prevented properly formed SOAP exceptions from being returned. This has been corrected so that SOAP clients will receive all reasons for log-in failures properly.

DM-626: Fix Potential XSS on Forms with Hidden Fields

Potential XSS issues were found with hidden fields. The names of all hidden fields are now encoded to prevent possible injections.

SM-125: Fix Potential XSS on Forms with Hidden Fields

Potential XSS issues were found with hidden fields. The names of all hidden fields are now encoded to prevent possible injections.
